

**MINUTES
IPSWICH CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2013**

Call the meeting to order: Mayor Kilber called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Motions: All motions were approved unanimously unless otherwise indicated.

Appoint New Council Member – Ward 1: Mayor Kilber mentioned there are several people interested in the vacant seat on the council. He asked if a special election was the best option.

Gillick/Gilbert to appoint Cindy Dosch for the vacant seat in Ward 1. Roll call vote: Uttenhove-no; Geditz-no; Thares-no; Gillick-yes; Gilbert-yes. Motion defeated.

Uttenhove/Thares to appoint Donald Miller for the vacant seat in Ward 1. Roll call vote: Uttenhove-yes; Geditz- yes; Thares- yes; Gillick-yes; Gilbert-yes. Motion carried.

Variance Request & Sewer Hook-up – S & S Rentals – 205 9th Street: Mike Hammrich, S&S Rentals, discussed changes being made to the proposed housing unit being built at 205 9th Street. Uttenhove/Geditz to approve the variance request. Motion carried.

Thares/Uttenhove to approve the request to connect to the city sewer on the property. Motion carried.

Donald Miller took the Oath of Office.

2014 Budget Planning and review: The council, with citizen input, reviewed and continued planning the 2014 Budget.
