Code Enforcement

City code enforcement plays an important role in keeping our community safe, clean, and welcoming. Please use the city-wide clean-up to bring your properties up to code. Common areas of focus include tall grass, weeds, junk and debris, inoperable vehicles, nuisance properties, and other maintenance concerns. Any property in violation will be contacted via letter to the homeowner.

REMINDER- Per city ordinance 3-7-2, individuals are allowed to have up to 6 chicken hens at their residence. Please be aware of the limit of 6 hens and no roosters.
