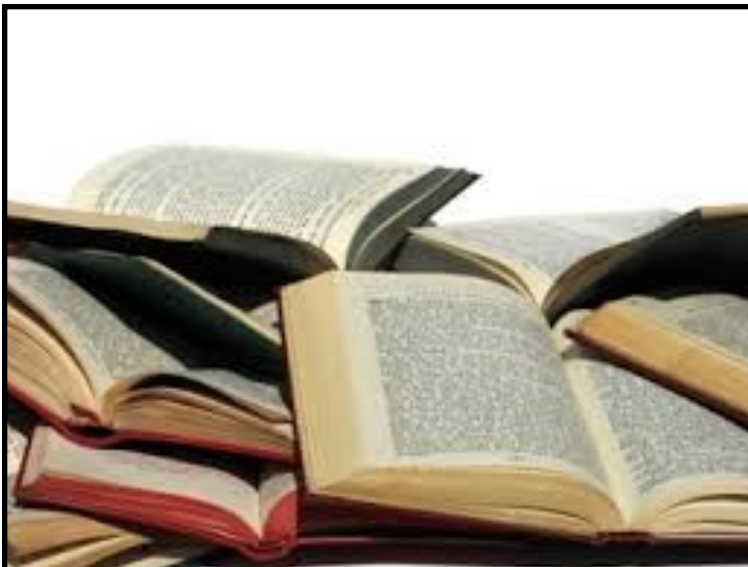
Some conditions constituting a nuisance include but not limited to:

Buildings that are abandoned, boarded up, partially destroyed or expiration of a building permit. Buildings with deteriorating or peeling paint, broken windows and/or doors. Overgrown vegetation. Dead, decayed, or diseased trees or weeds. Trash, garbage cans, bins, boxes, bags or other containers stored in the front yard visible from public streets. Abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, inoperative trailers, campers, boats and other motor vehicles. Abandoned furniture, appliances, or equipment visible at ground level from a public street, alley, or adjoining premises. Building exteriors, walls, fences, driveways, or walkways that are broken, defective, or deteriorated. Any like and similar condition or conditions.

Letters to homes that need to have action taken will be sent. If no action is taken, the city shall manage the maintenance and the homeowner will be charged accordingly. Thank you for helping make Ipswich a beautiful place for our residents and visitors.
