

TIGER POST DISCIPLINE PLAN

Updated August 2017

The purpose of the Tiger Post Discipline Plan is to promote a safe and nurturing environment where children are free to be themselves and learn positive, constructive behaviors. This plan is designed to promote good citizenship placing an emphasis on students reaching self-discipline. In addition, it will help students with the following general Tiger Post rules:

- CHILDREN WILL TREAT SELF AND OTHERS WITH DIGNITY, WORTH AND RESPECT.
- CHILDREN WILL TREAT ALL PROPERTY WITH RESPECT.
- CHILDREN WILL COOPERATE AND BE HELPFUL.
- CHILDREN WILL DEMONSTRATE POLITENESS AND GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP.
- CHILDREN WILL HAVE A RIGHT TO BE SAFE.

A consistent discipline plan at the Tiger Post should benefit the children and staff. The children will be held accountable for their behavior. All parents/guardians and students will sign a behavior contract when registering at Tiger Post. The following is a list of infractions and consequences.

Some infractions are but not limited to:

- Stealing
- Abusive or offensive language towards other children and staff
- Deliberate defacing/harming of Tiger Post property/other children's property
- Bullying
- Fighting/physical violence
- Excessive disruption of activities/repeatedly refuses to follow rules
- Refusal to follow disciplinary measures (talks back, refuses time out, etc.)

Consequences: The level is up to the discretion of the staff based on severity of the infraction

- **First incident** – warning and time out
- **Second incident** – staff and parent/guardian must sign incident form. Time out. No daily privileges for the day.
- **Third incident** – parent/guardian will be notified by phone. Staff and parent/guardian must sign form. Time out. No daily privileges for the day. Student will receive a 1-day suspension from the Tiger Post following day of occurrence.

If behavior does not resolve, result could be multiple day suspension or termination from Tiger Post.

** All consequences are subject to staff discretion depending on the severity and behavior. The staff will take appropriate action to deal with the issue in the fairest manner possible. Beyond the first incident, parents will be involved either by phone or when picking up the child. By doing this, we hope to keep the Tiger Post a safe, enriching, fun environment for the children. We would appreciate the help of parents/guardians to carry through with these expectations when the children are at the Tiger Post.
